Organizational View

For problem solving to be inclusive and hold all parties accountable, representatives from each level of the system should be involved. This includes line officers, civilian support staff, community organizations, and businesses or public sector organizations as relevant.



Depending on need and capacity, an agency might decide to establish a CompStat360 problem-solving team (PST) made up of representatives from the units and partners needed to address the problem. The PST can serve as a dedicated group of representatives to review, analyze, and determine possible solutions to specific priority issues.
